
Trentham Academy is leading on technological innovations across schools in the area.




We are a technology-rich environment that supports learning goals and inspires student creativity, collaboration and critical thinking. This technology cultivates an environment in

We offer a wide range of extra-curricular activities, giving numerous opportunities for leadership, teamwork and competition.


